

## How does online tutoring work?

First of all you will need to register with an online tutoring service provider. Generally all tutors charge a different rate and the rate is listed with the tutor's listing. After selecting a tutor you will then need to fix an appointment with the tutor you have selected.

During an online tutoring session, the tutor will sit on his computer far away from you while you are at your home. Good tutoring service providers use advanced technology which lets tutors present material on their computer to students allowing students and tutors to work on the material on a "whiteboard" at the same time. The whiteboard is nothing but an online version of physical classroom blackboard and allows the tutor to write on the board in real-time.

Words can be written or illustrations can be drawn with the help of mouse or keyboard on a whiteboard. Some of the online tutoring service providers also offer voice over IP. This means both the student and tutor can speak through the computer as long as both have a microphone and speakers. Online tutoring sessions will occur in "real time", meaning questions of the students are answered immediately, that means you have complete control over the tutoring session whether it is the subject matter or the pace of tutoring.
